Mullavilly Outreach 'at Home' – Apple Blossom Baby Basics

Among other activities and events, the Apple Blossom Baby Basics project is part of our outreach into the wider community, taking in the SHSCT and at times beyond that. We aim to assist those who have fallen on difficult times when expecting a new baby and can provide a Moses Basket and/or a Baby Bath filled with essential items to help them get started. Sometimes we are able to provide a pram or a cot or a highchair if these are available.

All items are donated, knit, or crocheted, (new mattresses for baskets are always purchased) and are packed and prepared by a dedicated group of volunteers. We are always in need of more volunteers, if you would like to find out more, or even be on the list of helpers, you would be very welcome indeed, so please do get in touch.
